

Infection Prevention Education Resources for Long-Term Care Facilities

In a high-risk setting like a COVID-19 outbreak, LTCFs need to have very strong infection prevention policies and practices to prevent the spread of disease. Effective infection control requires that every staff member knows your facility's infection control policies and acts accordingly. Additionally, every staff member needs to know how and when to appropriately use PPE. This document contains resources you can use to educate your employees about infection prevention.

Infection Prevention Basics

Hand Hygiene

- Handwashing Video: One-minute video demonstrating proper handwashing technique.
- <u>Hand Rub Video</u>: One-minute video demonstrating proper technique for using alcohol-based hand rub.
- <u>Hand Hygiene Competency Validation</u>: Can be used to assess hand hygiene competency for all staff members.
- <u>Hand Hygiene Posters</u>: Posters demonstrating when and how to perform hand hygiene from the World Health Organization.
- <u>Hand Hygiene Pocket Guides</u>: Pocket guides listing steps on how to use pocket hand sanitizer to prevent contaminating hands.

Appropriate Use of PPE

- <u>PPE Video</u>: Two-minute video demonstrating proper donning (putting on) and doffing (taking off) of PPE.
- <u>PPE Competency Validation</u>: Can be used to assess if all staff members know how to appropriately use PPE.
