# **Background**

- 2015: Session Law 2015-245 directs the Department to transition to managed care
- 2015-2018: Extensive collaboration with and feedback from stakeholders
- Aug 2018: RFP released
- Oct 2018: CMS approves 1115 waiver
- This week: PHP selection announced

# **Vision for Medicaid Managed Care**

"Improving the health and well-being of North Carolinians through an innovative, whole-person centered and well-coordinated system of care that addresses both medical and non-medical drivers of health."

## PHPs for NC Medicaid Managed Care

### Four statewide PHP contracts:

- AmeriHealth Caritas North Carolina, Inc.
- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina, Inc.
- UnitedHealthcare of North Carolina, Inc.
- WellCare of North Carolina, Inc.


### One regional provider-led entity:

- Carolina Complete Health, Inc.
- Regions 3 and 5

### **Prepaid Health Plan Contracts**

- Prepaid Health Plans will manage care for 1.6 million Medicaid beneficiaries
- Contracts are for Standard Plans; Behavioral Health Tailored Plans will be procured later
- PHPs will be subject to rigorous oversight to ensure:
  - Strong networks
  - Full range of benefits
  - Accountability for quality and outcomes
  - Positive beneficiary experience
  - Timely payments to providers
  - Many other aspects of successful managed care program

# NC Medicaid Managed Care Regions and Rollout Dates




Rollout Phase 1: Nov. 2019 - Regions 2 and 4

Rollout Phase 2: Feb. 2020 - Regions 1, 3, 5 and 6

## **Next Steps**

- Department will work with PHPs to prepare for the launch of Medicaid Managed Care, including system and operational readiness, and compliance with contract provisions
- PHPs and providers will discuss and enter into contracts to build networks
- Members will begin receiving information about enrolling in managed care, including how to select a PHP and primary care provider
- Department will conduct thorough readiness reviews to make sure PHPs are ready for managed care launch

## **Key Messages for Beneficiaries**

- Only thing beneficiaries need to do now is update their information
- Help will be available for beneficiaries to select a plan based on what makes the most sense for them
- Beneficiary rights will be protected
- Many things are <u>not</u> changing
  - Eligibility rules are the same
  - Same services/treatments/supplies will be covered
  - Cost-sharing is not changing
