Bus parking is available behind the museum in the Nova parking lot on the corner of Heritage Street and Caswell Street.



Civil War Medicine and Hygiene Demonstration

We have 3 options available for school groups (All groups will watch our ten-minute film first)

Option 1

- Life of a soldier/Civil War weapons and uniform talk, spinning, casemate demonstration (1 hour)

Option 2

- Civil War medicine/hygiene, life of soldier/Civil War weapons and uniform talk, 19th century toys and games (1 hour)

Option 3

- Civil War medicine/hygiene, rope making, life of a soldier/Civil War weapons and uniform talk, 19th century toys and games, casemate demonstration (1.5 hours)
