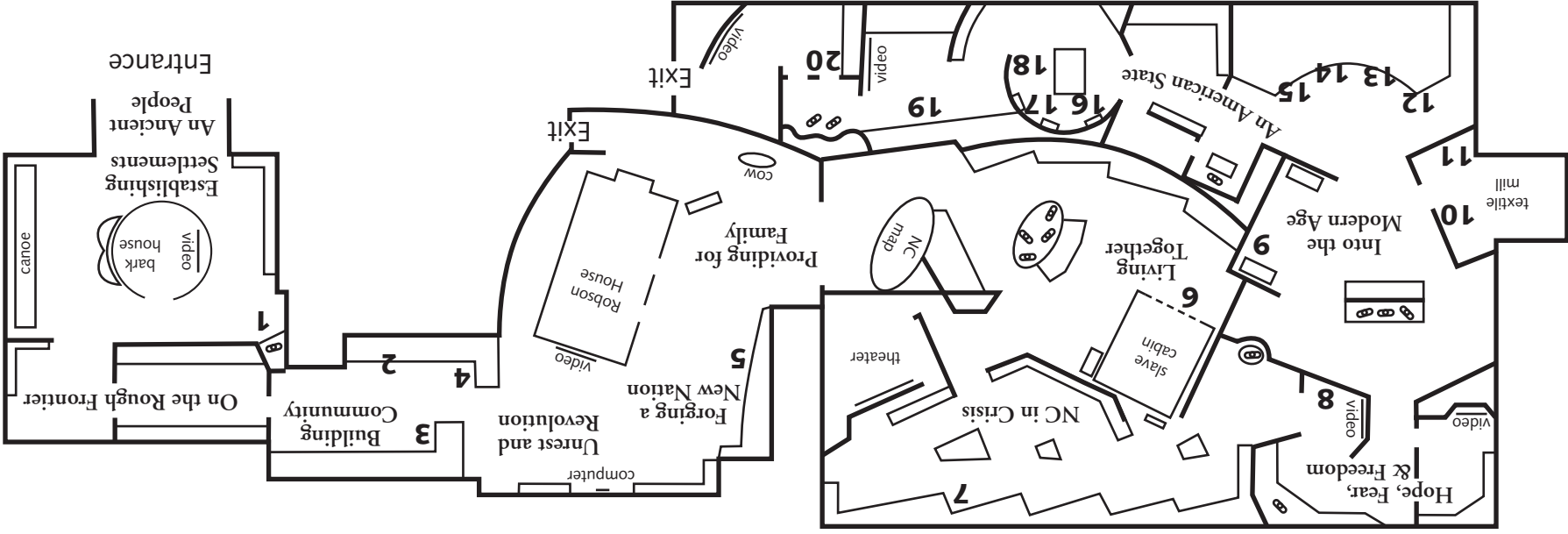


Women in The Story of North Carolina
