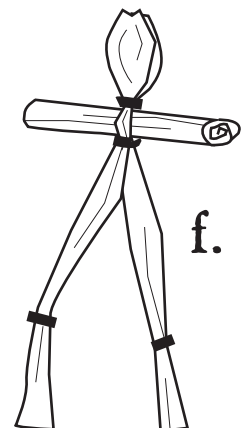
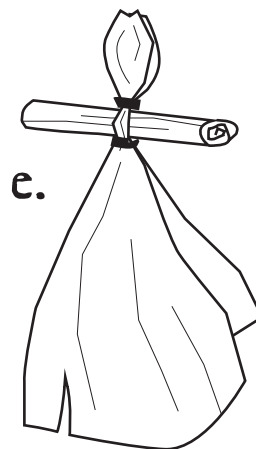
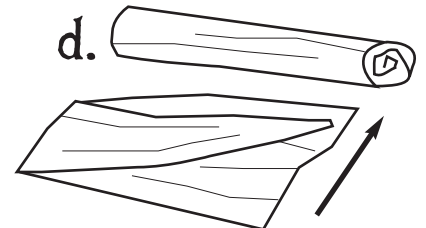
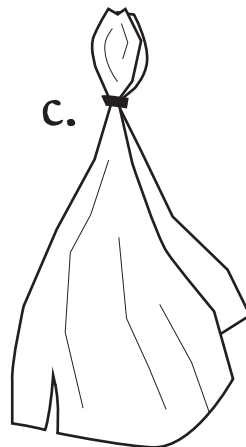
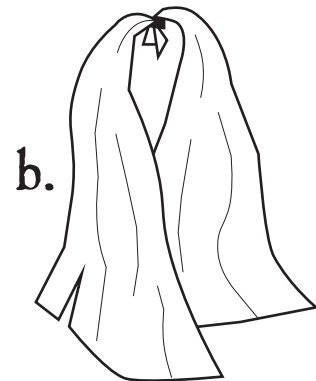
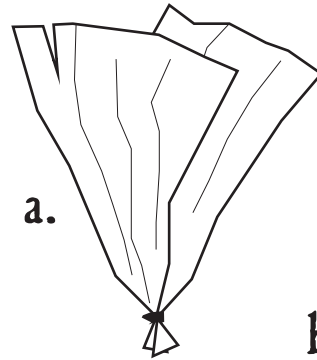


# Simplified Corn Husk Doll

water in bucket or pan  
corn husks (three per doll)  
thin twine or string or raffia twist  
scissors

Soak husks in water a few minutes to soften.

- a. Tie two husks together about one inch from their narrow ends. Trim twine.
- b. To form doll head fold husks down, encompassing tied ends within.
- c. Tie husks together about 1.5 inches below top of head to make neck. Trim twine.
- d. Fold third husk in half the short way – across the grain – then roll tightly with the grain to form arms.
- e. Place arms between the two other husks just below the neck tie. Tie the two husks snugly just below the arms. Trim twine. Stop at this point if you want a doll with a dress.
- f. For trousers, roll one of the husks below arms together to make a leg, then tie. Do the same with the other. Trim twine.



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
