

Title I Private School Equitable Share Calculation

Formula	Example Calculation
Private School Share = $A \times (B \div (B + C))$	= $5,000,000 \times (23 \div 7,623)$ = \$15,085 *

Variables	Example Values
A = Total current year allotment to the district	\$5,000,000
B = Low-income <u>private school</u> K-12 students who live in Title I-served areas	23
C = Low-income K-12 students attending the <u>district's</u> Title I-served schools	7,600

*Reasonable administrative costs may be paid out of the Title I private school share.

Title II or Title IV-A Private School Equitable Share Calculation

Formula	Example Calculation
Private School Share = $(D - E) \times (F \div (F + G))$	= $(1,400,000) \times (350 \div 20,350)$ = \$24,080

Variables	Example Values
D = Total current year allotment to the district	\$1,500,000
E = Reasonable administrative costs for public and private school programs (Unlike Title I, these costs will be paid from the district's share, not the private school share.)	\$100,000
F = Participating <u>private school</u> K-12 enrollment	350
G = District K-12 enrollment at all schools (must match ESSR data)	20,000

For Title III: In the D-E-F-G formula above, use a count of identified students instead of enrollment numbers for variables F and G.
