

NEW Grassroots Arts Program - Schedule of County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2018-19

These figures are based on a projected Grassroots allocation of \$3,103,708 according to a formula that assigns 20 percent in equal grants to all counties and 80 percent by population base. The formula uses a state population of 10,388,837 as determined by the 2018 population projection prepared by the State Data Center. The multicultural column shows the amount of the allotment that each county must spend on programming that reflects African American, Asian American, Latino, and Native American cultures. Allotments are rounded to the nearest dollar.
