

**Grassroots Arts Program - Tentative Schedule of County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2021-22**

These figures are based on a projected Grassroots allocation of \$2,803,708 according to a formula that assigns 20 percent in equal grants to all counties and 80 percent by population base. The formula uses a state population of 10,658,717 as determined by the 2021 population projection prepared by the State Data Center. The multicultural column shows the amount of the allotment that each county must spend on programming that reflects African American, Asian American, Native American, and Hispanic cultures. Allotments are rounded to the nearest dollar.
