

2019/2020 North Carolina Diesel Emissions Reduction Grant (DERG) Notice of Intent to Participate

GENERAL INFORMATION

This 2019/2020 *Notice of Intent to Participate* (NOIP) is due on or before **11:59 pm Eastern Time Friday, August 14, 2020** to daq.msrb.ncdaqgrants@ncdenr.gov. This Notice identifies plans for submitting an application to receive funding through the 2019/2020 North Carolina DERG Program.

Allowable activities are described in the 2019/2020 North Carolina Diesel Emissions Reduction Grant Request for Proposals Guidance found in the Associated Files Section of our website [Mobile Source Emissions Reduction Grants](#).

By submitting this NOIP, applicants will be provided with a link to training on the North Carolina Division of Air Quality's Grant Management System (GMS) which will serve as the repository for all applications, contracts, invoices, and other documentation required for this program. A question and answer session on application submittal will take place on **Friday, August 21 2020 at 10:00 am Eastern Time** via WebEx, a link to which will be sent upon receiving your NOIP.

All applications must be submitted through the NC Division of Air Quality's Grant Management System at [DAQ Grant Management System](#) and must be completed by **11:59 pm Eastern Time, Wednesday, September 30, 2020**. In order to be granted access to the Grant Management System you must complete an access authorization form which will be emailed to applicants that complete the NOIP as described above or can be found in the Associated Files Section of our website [Mobile Sources Emissions Reductions Grant](#). Until you have received notification that your authorization has been granted you will not be able to log into the system to complete the application process.

Upon receipt of the applications, they will be evaluated for eligibility and completeness. A selection committee will determine which of the eligible applications will be awarded funding. Once the applicants have received award notification from the Secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality, contracts will be initiated. Upon receipt of a fully executed contract, applicants may begin work on projects and submit invoices and required documentation for reimbursement. All work must be completed by **September 1, 2022**.
