On March 1, 2019 Chemours submitted a proposal to retain Charles River Laboratories for the human health toxicity studies and EAG Laboratories for the aquatic life (ecological) toxicity studies under Paragraph 14 of the Consent Order. On March 11, DEQ approved the use of Charles River Laboratories and asked for additional information regarding both laboratories. On May 9, Chemours submitted the requested information which has been reviewed by DEQ.

Pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Consent Order and based on the initial proposal and additional information submitted by Chemours regarding the laboratories, this letter serves as the DEQ approval of EAG Laboratories for the aquatic life (ecological) toxicity studies.
