Re: Consent Order Paragraph 19

Dear Mr. Long,

Paragraph 19 of the Consent Order states that Chemours shall establish and properly maintain permanent replacement drinking water supplies for any party with a private drinking water well that has been contaminated with concentrations of Gen X compounds in excess of 140 ng/L, or any applicable health advisory, whichever is lower. Permanent replacement drinking water supplies must be installed within nine months after the date Chemours becomes aware that the affected party qualifies for replacement water, or, if Chemours was aware of such qualification at the time of entry of the Consent Order, within nine months after the date of the entry.

DEQ has reviewed the August 9, 2019 letter from Chemours to include the requests for appropriate extensions of applicable deadlines. Paragraph 25 of the Consent Order allows for Chemours to seek one or more extensions of up to three months for such deadlines for good cause.

Therefore, DEQ hereby grants an extension of 3 months, until February 25, 2020, for the company to comply with the requirements of paragraph 19 of the Consent Order for the affected wells in Bladen and Cumberland County west of the Cape Fear River. Further, DEQ concurs with Chemours proposed approach for the affected wells while DEQ continues its evaluation of the Feasibility Study Report for Public Water for those areas west of the Cape Fear River.
