RE: Consent Order Paragraph 26 – Request for Extension of Deadline

Dear Mr. Long:

This letter responds to your request that the deadline under paragraph 26 of the Consent Order for the submission of the Total Organic Fluorine (TOF) methodology by Dr. Susan D. Richardson of the University of South Carolina be extended three months. In your letter you cite COVID-19 delays as the reason for requesting a three-month extension of the March 31, 2021 deadline to submit the TOF methodology to June 30, 2021. In a separate letter Dr. Richardson described the partial shutdown of the University of South Carolina as a consequence of COVID-19 and the resulting inability to operate the laboratory at full capacity, thereby delaying the work on the TOF methodology. Because of the delay in Dr. Richardson's work, DEQ grants the extension for timely submission of the total organic fluorine method under the Consent Order to June 30, 2021.
