This is to notify the public by the North Carolina Division of Waste Management's Hazardous Waste Section of its intent to issue a Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) Renewal Permit for the former DuPont Brevard Hazardous Waste Facility located at 701 DuPont Drive in Cedar Mountain, Transylvania County, North Carolina.

A public hearing will be held at 1:00 pm on Friday, August 7, 2020, at the Brevard City Hall Council Chambers located at 95 West Main Street in Brevard, North Carolina. Additionally, due to public health guidance to reduce the spread of COVID-19, a digital public hearing will also be conducted on Tuesday, August 11, 2020, at 11:00 am. All attendees will have the opportunity to present five-minute oral statements regarding the draft renewal permit and/or to submit written comments and data at the public hearing. You may also submit written comments at any time during the forty-five-day public comment period, which begins on July 8, 2020, and ends on August 22, 2020. A summary of the renewal permit follows:

This HSWA-Only Renewal Permit is for corrective action only. DuPont began operations at the facility in 1957 producing high purity silicon under the Chemicals and Pigments Department. The property was then transferred to the Imaging Department for production of medical imaging (x-ray) films. The facility ceased operations in 2002, and all manufacturing processes, process buildings, and assets were removed from the site. Hazardous waste is no longer generated or stored at the facility.

Investigation and remediation activities have been ongoing at the site since the 1980s. The final remedy for the site was presented in the *Remedial Action Plan (RAP)* which was approved by NCDEQ in December 2016. DuPont then transferred ownership of the site to the State of North Carolina in December 2016. The property is now part of the DuPont State Recreational Forest. The HSWA-Only Renewal Permit addresses implementation of corrective actions in accordance with the RAP.

All comments received during the public comment period or at the hearing will be considered in the decision to issue, deny, or modify this renewal permit. Comments received after the public comment period ends will not be considered. The statutory authority for calling the permit hearing is G.S. 130A-294(f). Applicable State rules are found in the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules 15A NCAC 13A .0105, .0109, and .0113. These rules adopt the requirements of the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act as amended by the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984.
