Notes:

Event occurred in wake of Hurricane Florence. Fish observed from Crusoe to SC state line (45 river miles). Approximately 10 fish per 100 yards of shoreline, more fish aggregated at some bridge crossings and boating access areas (e.g., Dock Rd bridge, Pireway BAA). Total losses are incalculable but certainly exceed 100,000 fish.
