Requirements of 2007 statute

Additional Considerations

- Co-applicant Requirements

Applicant may not resell IBT water to another public water supply system UNLESS that system is listed as co-applicant on certificate

- Drought Management Plan

Plan must include mandatory reductions in transfer based on severity and duration of drought.


- Water Conservation Plan

Plan must ensure efficient use of transferred water. Plan should equal or exceed the most stringent water conservation measures implemented by community water system in source basin.


Requirements of 2013 IBT Statute

New Transfer


I. Applicant submits Notice of Intent to file a petition.



II. Applicant submits draft environmental document (EIS or EA) for review process




III. Applicant submits petition to EMC
