

# Optimization of IT resources in NC

In 2015, the NC General Assembly passed a law requiring the Department of Information Technology to manage most of the “enterprise information technology functions” in the executive branch, following a nationwide IT consolidation trend.

NC DIT believes the General Assembly’s directive is an opportunity to optimize the state’s IT resources, to improve IT procurement and services statewide and to continue to build DIT as the first and foremost resource for information technology in North Carolina.

We know, however, that it is likely you have some questions and concerns as you move from DOT to DIT. We are committed to making your transition as easy as possible.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How does this affect me directly?

The major change is that your pay schedule will change from every other week to every month. However, you will not experience a delay or gap in your pay. You will receive your last DOT (biweekly) paycheck July 13, 2018. You will receive your first monthly paycheck from DIT on July 31.

### Will my benefits change?

Your core state benefits will remain the same. However, some DOT-specific providers, such as Humana Dental, will change. Further, if you elected to purchase supplemental benefit options through DOT-sponsored providers, you will have the opportunity to consider similar supplemental coverage. DIT human resources staff members will provide details.

### Will my supervisor change?

Your supervisor will remain the same. Your supervisor will continue to approve your time and travel-related expenses in the SAP system you are already using. System changes are underway to make this seamless.

### Will I receive a new email address?

You will receive a new "nc.gov" email; however, your previous DOT email address will continue to work as always.

### Will I lose my parking assignment?

No. Some DOT parking is assigned according to the number of years with the department. Your parking privileges will not be affected.
