



NEW Statewide Term Contract

Effective Dates: July 17, 2019 – July 16, 2022

35,000 & 50,000-70,000 GVWR Cab & Chassis Trucks – 070E

The Division of Purchase & Contract has established a new Statewide Term Contract to provide 35,000 GVWR (medium duty) and 50,000-70,000 GVWR (heavy duty) cab and chassis trucks.

This contract is a mandatory Statewide Term Contract for state agencies, departments, institutions, universities and community colleges, unless exempted by North Carolina General Statute. Additionally, non-mandatory entities, including schools and local government, that are allowed by general statute may use this contract.

New Contract Highlights

This contract replaces the previous Statewide Term Contracts STC 070J and STC 070Q that were issued under IFB 201301537 and IFB 201400104.

This new contract combines the previous Statewide Term Contracts and features multiple options of truck configurations to improve contract efficiency and to increase the depth and breadth of products offered.

All awarded vendors have dedicated account representatives to ensure that agencies receive the utmost level of customer service and efficient placement of orders.

All vendors will deliver within 120 consecutive calendar days after receipt of a purchase order. Agencies are advised to immediately inspect all shipments for damage prior to order acceptance.
