COVID-19 UPDATE

Offender Statistics

- 33,363 Offenders tested
- 1,970 Positive Results
- 31,393 Negative Results
- 1,624 Recovered Offenders
- **10 Offender Deaths**
- Overall positivity rate 5.9%

Data as of 8/30/20

Mass Testing Operation

Mass testing of all offenders housed in NC Prisons commenced on June 22, 2020 and concluded on August 6, 2020.

2.1% Positivity Rate

Employee Statistics

- 645 Staff Positives
- 503 Recovered Staff
- 142 still out of work

Data as of 8/27/20

Since May 2020, staff have had unlimited access to free COVID-19 testing. **Currently available** thru October 31, 2020.


PREVENT, PROTECT, PREPARE



- Created, produced, and distributed over 300,000 face masks to state/local agencies and active/retired state employees.
- Division of Prisons ordered 600,000 3-ply cloth face masks to be distributed to staff and offenders. Staff and offenders will receive five each once order is fulfilled.
- Correction Enterprise continues to distribute face masks, gowns, face shields, health partitions, floor decals, posters, and alcohol & non-alcohol based hand sanitizer.

Taser Rollout

- Pilot was implemented in four close custody facilities in 2019
 - Maury
 - Scotland
 - Marion
 - Pasquotank
- Rollout complete at all 12 close custody facilities as of 9/1/20.

 that provides stretch, lighter
 weight, and increased
 durability.

Telehealth

Current Status

- Telehealth unit in every NC Prison.
- Approximately 40,000 Tele Psychiatry encounters since 2019 inception.
- 30 different specialty medical clinics in operation averaging 180 encounters per week.
- Staffing consists of 250 specialists from the UNC Healthcare System.
- Projected reduction in ER visits.

Benefits

- Less offender transport outside of secure prison.
- Positive impact on officer staffing.
- Reduced offender and staff exposure to COVID-19
- More timely access to care for offenders



New Custody Classification Instrument

- Took effect on August 5, 2020
- Different instruments for male and female offenders.
- Used for both initial and annual classification reviews.
- Researched and developed in consultation with the National Institute of Corrections




