


Install, Connect and Log In

Install the App




Download and install the **SAS Mobile BI** App from the Google Play store.

Connect to Server



Open the App and select **Settings** from the App menu.



On the Settings screen, select **Add Connection**.

Select **Log on as guest** and then select **Next**.


Note: If you change the text under “Miscellaneous” (guest@ncgdacva.ondemand.sas.com), you cannot tap **Next** to continue.

Select **Next** to complete the connection verification step.


Note: A message will appear briefly stating that the connection was successfully added.


Add Reports




Access the **Library** and follow the path **guest@ncgdacva.ondemand.sas.com**.



Select **OSBM** and then select the report you want to access.




Select the report called **“Search”**.



Select **Subscribe** to access the report.
