CARES Act

- Passed March 27, 2020
- North Carolina's allocation is \$4 billion
- Guilford, Mecklenburg, and Wake Counties and City of Charlotte received funds directly

Session Law 2020-4


- Signed by the Governor on May 4, 2020
- Reserved \$300 million for local governments
 - ✓ Appropriates \$150 million to 97 Counties



Funding Allocation

Two Step Methodology

- Each county allocated \$250,000 base
- Balance allocated based on 2019 county population

 - ✓ Will use appropriately
 - ✓ Provide a Plan by June 1
 - ✓ Subject to claw back
 - ✓ Conform with reporting requirements

W-9 Form



CARES Act Requirements

- Necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019;
- Not accounted for in the most recently approved budget, as of March 27, 2020 for the State or government; and
- Incurred during the period of March 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020.



Federal Treasury Guidance

- Medical Expenses
- Public Health Expenses
- Payroll Expenses
- Action to Facilitate Public Health Measures
- Expenses associated with the provision of economic support (NOT REVENUE REPLACEMENT)
- Any Other COVID-19-Related Expenses



Other Federal Guidance

- No double dipping
- No Government revenue replacement
- All unspent funds as of December 30, 2020 must be returned



State Guidance

- Funding priority list
- Municipalities
- NC Pandemic Recovery Office (NCPRO)



Reporting Requirements

Must Submit a Plan

- The plan is due by June 1, 2020
- NC PRO will provide a form
- Report expense in six categories

Must Report on Use of Funds

- County will report on Municipality uses
- Due October 1, 2020 and January 1, 2021
- Includes
 - ✓ Use of funds
 - ✓ Unspent amounts
- NC PRO will provide a form
