STOP, LOOK, LISTEN

Always take time to observe your surroundings before crossing the street. Look left, look right, and look left again.



USE CROSSWALKS

Use crosswalks whenever you can. If there are no crosswalks, then you should cross at the nearest intersection.



SEE AND BE SEEN

Always make sure you can clearly be seen by drivers. Cross in open areas free of obstruction and wear bright colors at night.



MAKE EYE CONTACT

It establishes non-verbal communication between you and the driver, which helps keep everyone safe.
