

LAW ENFORCEMENT DIRECTOR

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Positions in this banded class direct a statewide law enforcement operation such as the SBI, ALE, Marine Fisheries Enforcement, Wildlife Enforcement, Highway Patrol, or similar operation charged with enforcing the relevant laws of the State of North Carolina. Positions have full law enforcement authority in the assigned area ranging from patrol activities to deter and detect violations to conducting criminal investigations and have statewide and/or special jurisdiction. Positions serve as the Director responsible for developing policy and procedure, planning and organizing operations, managing budget development and related resource allocation, and maintaining appropriate relations with local and other State law enforcement agencies and with the media.

Minimum Training and Experience: Bachelor's degree and two years of progressive supervisory/managerial law enforcement experience in the area of assignment; or equivalent combination of training and experience. Certification as a Law Enforcement Officer in accordance with the provisions of the North Carolina Criminal Justice Training and Standards Commission or the ability to achieve certification within one year of employment. All degrees must be received from appropriately accredited institutions.
