

LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Positions in this banded class serve as field officer in a statewide law enforcement operation such as the SBI, ALE, Marine Fisheries Enforcement, Wildlife Enforcement, Highway Patrol, or similar operation having statewide and/or special jurisdiction charged with enforcing the relevant laws of the State of North Carolina. Positions have full law enforcement authority in the assigned area with a focus on patrol activities to deter and detect violations but may participate in criminal investigations. Work involves responding to and investigating complaints or calls, detecting violations, apprehending observed violators committing offenses, collection and preservation of evidence, testimony in court proceedings as necessary, and performing related work.

Minimum Training and Experience: High school diploma or equivalency. Certification as a Law Enforcement Officer in accordance with the provisions of the North Carolina Criminal Justice Training and Standards Commission or the ability to achieve certification within one year of employment.

Special Note - This is a generalized representation of positions in this class and is not intended to identify essential functions per ADA. Examples of work are primarily essential functions of the majority of positions in this class, but may not be applicable to all positions.
