

MACHINE OPERATOR IV

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Work in this class involves the safe and efficient operation of the following equipment:

Backhoe Operator supervising drainage crew Bulldozer used in precision earthwork operations Center Line Paint Gun Operator in Charge or Center Line Driver in Charge Motor Grader used in precision earthwork operations Motor Grader Mower Pan (Scraper)

Work is performed under general supervision except in cases of unusual work problems.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES PERFORMED

Operates backhoe, primarily in ditching and pipe laying operations and supervising drainage crew.

Operates bulldozer, clearing land, moving materials, and cuts grades to desired level (Precision Earthwork Operations).

Operates motor grader, machines top of unpaved roads, ditches and shoulders, and grades new roads to stakes (Precision Earthwork Operations).

Operates motor grader mower, cutting large or heavy underbrush.

Operates pan (scraper), cutting down hills or filling low areas.

Performs related work as required.

RECRUITMENT STANDARDS

Knowledges, Skills, and Abilities

Working knowledge of the principles involved in the operation and use of the equipment to which assigned.

Working knowledge of road maintenance and construction procedures and standards.

Demonstrated ability to operate assigned machine effectively.

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

Minimum Education and Experience

Sufficient experience to operate effectively the machine to which assigned.
