

AUTO PAINTER

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

This is skilled work in refinishing and painting automotive equipment. Work assignments are received from a shop foreman, and employees independently determine work methods in accordance with standard automotive painting practices. Work is inspected by a shop foreman during progress or at completion for workmanship and compliance with work orders.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES PERFORMED

Mixes paints to desired color and prepares spraying equipment such as cleaning or adjusting spray gun.

Cleans vehicle to be painted; masks glass and chromium areas and applies paint with spray gun or brush.

Hand letters signs or stripes cars and trucks.

Paints highway signs, wooden trailers, and other related equipment. Performs related duties as required.

RECRUITMENT STANDARDS

Knowledges, Skills, and Abilities

Working knowledge of the standard methods and practices of automotive painting and of the materials and methods used in painting or refinishing.

Skill in the use and operation of automotive painting equipment.

Ability to lay out and paint signs including free-hand lettering.

Minimum Education and Experience

Completion of grammar school and two years of progressive experience in the painting of automobiles; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
