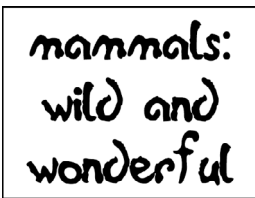
Summer Day Camp: Paleo Camp

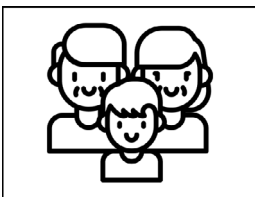
Haw River Adventure Day Camp
