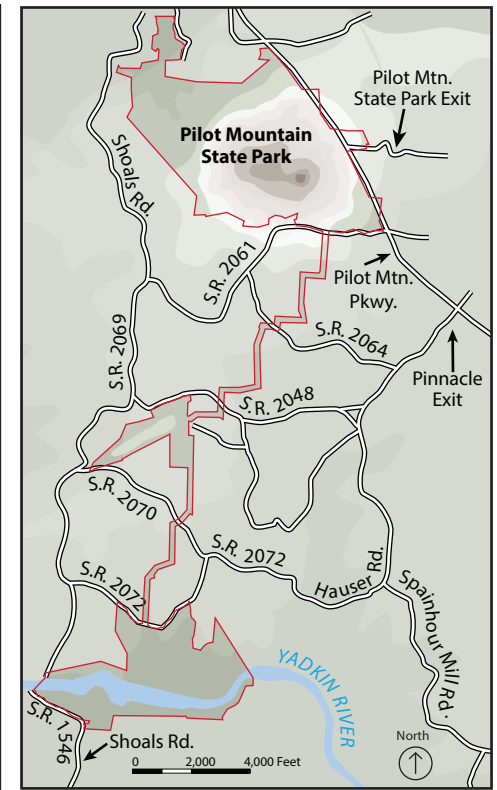
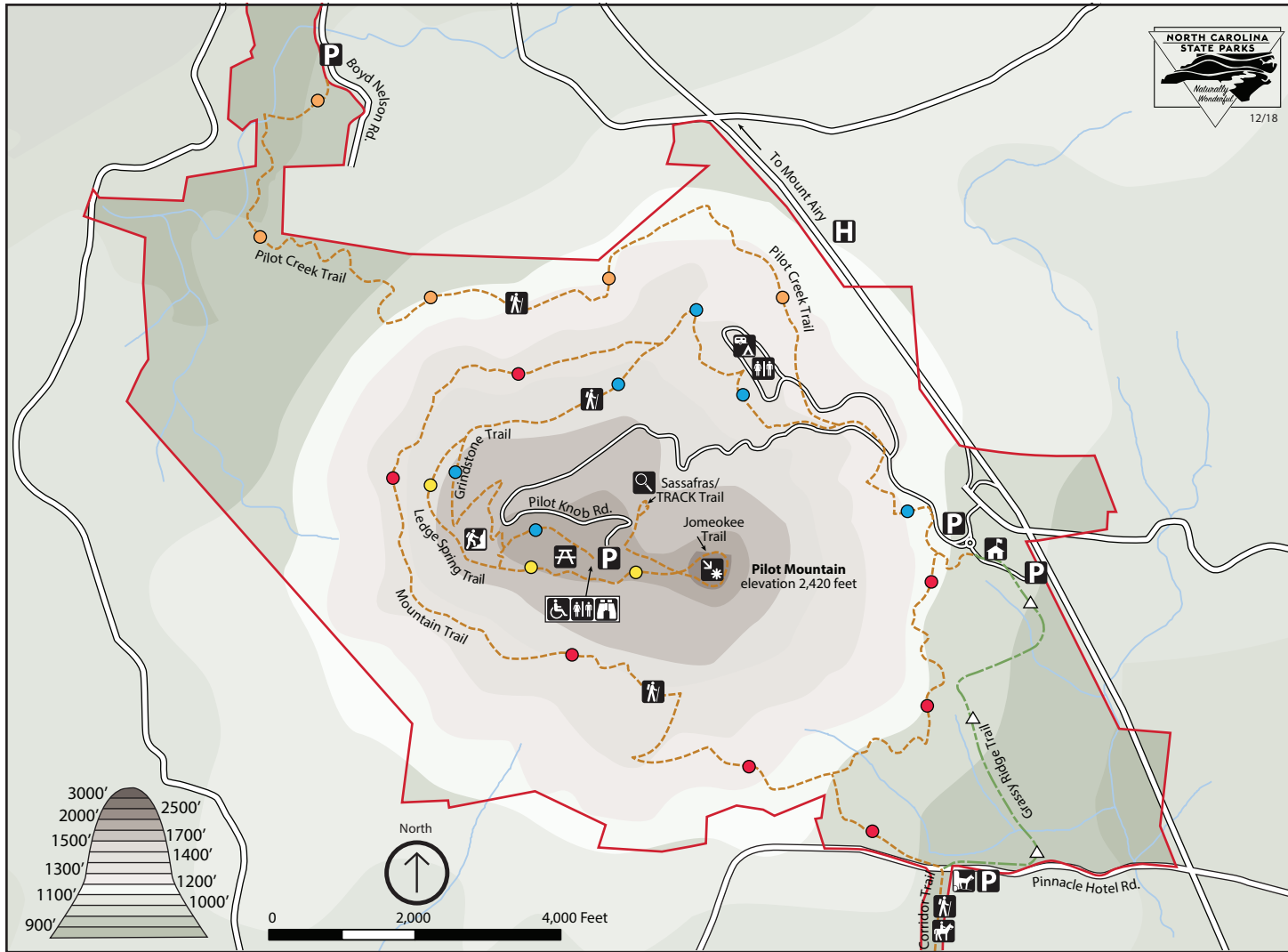


Pilot Mountain State Park

MOUNTAIN SECTION



To Boyd Nelson Rd. parking area (Pilot Creek Trailhead): Continue north on U.S. 52 to the town of Pilot Mountain exit. Turn left off the ramp. Turn west on N.C. 268 for 0.2 mile, then south on Shoals Rd. After 0.5 mile turn left on Boyd Nelson Rd. to reach the trailhead.

To Culler Rd. parking area (Mountain & Corridor trails): From the park entrance, turn right on Pilot Knob Park Rd. At the stop sign, turn right on Old Winston Rd. Go to the stop sign. Turn right on Old Hwy. 52 South. At the post office turn right on Surry Line Rd. Follow this road for 2 miles to the intersection with Culler Rd. and the parking area.

The portion of Mountain-to-Sea Trail that runs through the park starts at the southern end of the Corridor Trail and travels to the Mountain Trail, past the family campground on the Grindstone Trail, and heads east out of the park on the Sauratown Trail below the park office. Follow the white circle blazes.
