Your entire class can paddle in N.C. State Parks and participate in an unforgettable science lesson!

- Two 29-foot canoes that can hold 14 people each
- Lessons accommodate up to 78 students
 - 26 students can paddle at a time
 - 52 students can participate in land-based science lessons while peers are paddling.
- Ideal for grades 4-12
- North Carolina correlated lesson topics include:
 - food webs
 - aquatic ecosystems
 - animal adaptations
 - water cycle
 - litter cleanup
 - people and our waterways
- Safety precautions include properly fitted life vests and expert guides.
- Students learn the fundamentals of water safety.
- Program is free for North Carolina Schools. Funding for bus transportation may be available through Friends of State Parks.
