Brief Description of Program:

The federal HPF grant to the Office of Archives and History enables the North Carolina State Historic Preservation Office to continue to carry out the National Register of Historic Places program which includes a statewide survey, nominations of properties to the National Register, environmental review, tax credit reviews, technical assistance to local historic preservation commissions, public education activities, comprehensive historic preservation planning, and **matching grants-in-aid for local historic preservation projects and programs** having as their purpose the identification and evaluation of historic properties for the National Register and the protection and enhancement of properties listed in the National Register.
