Statewide Term Contract Announcements

Statewide Term Contract 880A The Division of Purchase & Contract has established a new [Statewide Term Contract 880A – Audio Visual and Photographic Equipment and Accessories](#). This is a multiple-vendor mandatory contract for state agencies, departments, institutions, universities and community colleges - unless exempted by North Carolina General Statute. Additionally, non-

mandatory entities, including schools and local governments, that are allowed by general statute may use this contract. The contract term is February 18, 2020 through February 17, 2023.
