1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The State of North Carolina, Department of Public Safety, Office of Recovery and Resiliency is in the process of developing plans to provide elevation services for homes affected by Hurricane Matthew and Florence in the Eastern and Southeastern counties of NC. (See attached map)

The State of North Carolina (the State) has received approximately \$236.5 million in CDBG-DR awards to date for Hurricane Matthew (DR-4285). The State anticipates an additional \$168 million for mitigation projects. The State will receive CDBG-DR funds following Hurricane Florence (DR-4393). North Carolina will receive at least \$336 million for Hurricane Florence recovery, and expects at least one additional substantial award. To meet the unprecedented challenge of recovering from two major disasters in two years, the State has established NCORR to be the new grantee agency for management of all CDBG-DR awards to the State.

Through the effort of providing rehabilitation to homes, the need to elevate certain homes is required. Through this Request for Information (RFI) NCORR is seeking information from qualified vendors as to the cost for providing elevation services for such homes to include: How cost is provided; what information will be needed in order for vendors to quote on projects, and unique aspects of elevation in the eastern half of North Carolina etc.

2.0 RFI PROCEDURES

A. Schedule

Respondents will have two weeks to prepare its submissions to this RFI. Responses must be received by the date, time and the location specified on the cover sheet of this RFI.

B. Clarification Questions

Clarification questions will be accepted until August 1, 2019 as specified on the cover sheet of this RFI. All questions must be submitted in writing. An addendum containing any general clarification questions and their answers will be issued as an addendum to this RFI.

C. Response

The State recognizes that considerable effort will be required in preparing a response to this RFI. **However,** please note this is a request for information only, and <u>not</u> a request for services. The Vendor shall bear all costs for preparing this RFI.


1. Content and Format

The response should define all services that would be required by the proposed solution. The response should also include:


- An estimated cost for the solution.
